## CBC Record Number of Certificates and Degrees Awarded

**BEEVILLE** – Coastal Bend College (CBC) had a record number of certificates and degrees awarded to students with 882 students receiving 1,429 certificates and degrees. The flexibility of CBC has enabled students to pursue certificates and degrees in a learning environment that works best for them.

Additionally, CBC had a record number of nursing graduates from CBC with 110 Vocational Nurses and 42 Professional Nurses. The range of classes taught by state certified teachers, extracurricular activities and the supportive community gave students of all abilities and backgrounds the chance to thrive in a learning environment that works for them.

Some key distinctions and numbers from the graduating class of 2018 are:

- 29% of graduates obtaining an Associate's degree graduated with honors
- 43% of the class of 2018 were high school students who haven't graduated high school.
- 24% of students completed the core curriculum and can transfer to a Texas public university.
- 33% completed a certificate or Associate's degree in an Allied Health field.
- 75 % of graduates earned a certificate or Associate's degree in a workforce related field.

The Nurse Pinning ceremony was held on May 15 at 6:30 p.m. and commencement ceremonies were held Wednesday, May 16 at 10 a.m., 1 p.m., and 5 p.m. at CBC Beeville's Peter S.
